

Notice to the Public
Regarding Changes to the Nevada Housing Division's
Rural Allocation of the Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that pursuant to provisions of the America Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program, the State of Nevada has completed and made available for public review changes to the rural allocation of the Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program originally identified in the Substantial Amendment to the Consolidated Annual Action Plan for the 2008-2009 Program Year that was submitted to HUD in May 2009 for the purpose of assisting in the prevention and housing of homeless and at-risk homeless households. Details of the Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program are described in the Federal Register notice Docket Number FR-5307-N-01.

The document is available for public review beginning **October 21, 2011** and is located on the State of Nevada's Housing Division Website at www.nvhousing.state.nv.us.
